



**A Urupā**  
 Parking area has been redefined with a sitting area to the side with an area to wash hands as one exits. There are a new series of pathways around the exterior with informal paths through the centre forming grids for new burial plots. New entrance gateway connecting to a pathway back to the Pa. New planting to soften the exterior of the site, but allowing for important views out to the landscape beyond. Overall layout is conceptual and will be refined.

**B Ara Tupuna**  
 Mown grass (or reinforced grass cell) walkway amongst specimen trees to the Urupa, with a formed seating lookout area on the high point. Pathway connects to an informal/overflow parking area next to the ablutions building.

**C Grazing**  
 Area to continue to be farmed for food and/or income. This area is in good proximity to easy access, for potential future development.

**D Upgraded buildings & connections**  
 Buildings upgraded as per architects plans with some small areas of amenity planting around the perimeter. An extended area of hardstand outside Te Aroha with a pathway connecting to the exterior of the area (along with a disability compliant pathway) that connects into the refurbished entry of Te Titohea.

**E Ātea**  
 Existing landform to be contoured to smooth out the levels and create a wider flat area at the top beside Te Aroha and Mahi Tamariki. This area is to either be left as grass or finished with a decorative surface.

**F Waharoa/Shelter**  
 The Waharoa to also become the shelter for those waiting to be welcomed. The design of the structure to mirror the Mahu extension on the front of Te Aroha/Te Titohea. Either side to have some low planting to define the edge of the atea with an option of a line of low bollards running through the middle.

**G Toilets**  
 New toilet block located near the pathway connecting the parking area with Te Titohea. One side accessed from the path and the other side opening into the play area.

**H Entry & Parking**  
 High amenity planting and pou situated at the entry to the site (in the same location as existing) leading to the formalised parking area with direct access to the Waharoa/ Shelter. Disability parking located close to the pathway, with additional vehicle parking nearby. Two/three dedicated bus parks located near the entry/road. Inlaid detailing extending across the unloading area/drive to direct visitors to the waharoa. A metal or formal driveway loop through the centre of the adjacent grass area to give access to overflow parking for larger gatherings.

**I Play Space**  
 Fenced play area located to the north of Te Titohea. New deck to wrap around the side of the Whare Kai with steps down into the area for ease of access. Area to have equipment, seating and trees/sails for shade. Additional informal seating and shade located to the south of the Whare Kai for the adults, with the Hangi in its current location, with the option of upgrading the space in the future.

**J Papakāinga & Māra**  
 Future option for the location for community housing and gardens located next to the Whare Kai. Area to have vehicle access to the overflow parking area with a gate and vegetation buffer for security/privacy with a possible additional or alternative access through the homestead. This area could continue to be grazed until developed.
